What Do I Need to Bring to Registration/Orientation?

To complete the registration/orientation process you must have the following items. If any of these items are not valid or missing, you will not be able to register that same day.

- 1. Your current government issued picture ID
- 2. Cash or money order in the amount of \$150 (NO checks or credit cards accepted)
- 3. Your HiSET user name and password, and your unique ETS number (you will be assigned this ETS number when you set up your account at http://hiset.ets.org/test_takers
- 4. Completed HiSET Registration Checklist (see back side of this form)

How Long is Registration/Orientation?

Plan on spending up to three hours to complete the registration/orientation.

How Many People Will be Tested on Each Exam Day?

The first 20-30 candidates (EVSC evening exams can only accommodate 20; NVOC can only accommodate 18) in line with the correct items listed above will be registered for the designated exam day/time. All other candidates will be asked to return for the next scheduled registration/orientation day/time, or be referred to alternate testing sites to take the exam.
